

## Simple Towel Topper

I used 1/2" seam allowances.

### Materials Needed

1. One hand towel cut in half will make two hanging towels.
2. Enough fabric to cut 4 fabric pieces and two buttons.

Cut 4 fabric pieces. Place right sides together, turn up a 1/2" hem on one side of the fabric. Sew around the outside edge.



After sewing around the edge clip inner curve and at an angle across each outer corner. Be careful not to cut any stitching.

Cut one towel in half then gather the cut edge using about a quarter inch stitch.

After you have press your top and gathered your towel top, place the wrong side of the towel to the longer tail at the bottom of your hanger. Stitch 1/2" across the top of the towel and hanger. Turn all raw edges to the inside of the of the hanger and top stitch across the top. Make your button holes and add your button. The button can be as simple or as fancy as you want it to be.



These towels make very nice inexpensive gifts.

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
